Final Conference held in Brussels

The final conference of the Agri-multifunctionality II project, entitled 'Investing in Young Farmers: Opportunities in Multifunctional Agriculture', has been held on 15 December at the European Economic and Social Committee in Brussels.

After the opening speech of the President of CEJA, Mr. Joris Baecke, a round table of experts from the European Commission, DG Agriculture and scientific institutes discussed the role of Multifunctional farming in the future of the CAP and the possibility to find new opportunities for young farmers in rural areas. Then three young farmers presented their experiences of multifunctional farming. These experiences have been converted in 3 of the 63 Case Studies from 21 European Countries which constitute the core of the training system developed during the project.

Finally Iacopo Benedetti, project coordinator from Granaforma S.L., presented the final product of the project: a training system made of a Teaching Guide for trainers and Case Studies designed as a work tool to facilitate the understanding and development of multifunctional activities in farming.

The main aim of this Training System is to show in practice how other farmers who had an idea of multifunctional farming have developed it, what problems they have had, what grants they received, how they started it up and what the final results of the adventure were.
